Conditions for Affiliated Shows 2017

1. An Affiliation Show Application Form must be completed and filed with the society giving the details of:
Date and venue of show.
Closing date for entries
Judges name(s)
List of classes on offer
2. There is NO Affiliation Fee charged
3. Where possible judges must be selected from the Society's list of current panel judges. A copy of the 2017 is listed on the society website: appaloosa.org.uk or a hard copy can be sent upon request to the Show Co-ordinator.
4. All exhibits in affiliated classes must be registered in the appropriate register of the society, in order to confirm correctness details of all exhibitors and horses must be sent to the Show Co-ordinator as soon as possible after the shows closing date where membership and registration will be checked. No exhibitors should be allowed to show in Affiliated Shows unless the handler or owner is a member of the society and the horse is registered in the appropriate register.
5. All Affiliated classes must be conducted as per the listing in the schedule. The wording of which should be agreed by the society Show Co-ordinator and the Show Secretary.
6. It is the responsibility of the Show Secretary to inform the society of the show results. This should be done as soon as possible.
7. All exhibitors will be sent an Affiliation Show Rosette once the results are known. BApS do not supply placing rosettes for the show except in exceptional circumstances.
8. Due to the recent decline in some show entry numbers the conditions for some Affiliated Shows must vary. Main Registered and Part Bred horses may be shown together. It is the responsibility of the society Show Co-ordinator to ensure the correct entry conditions are agreed for each Affiliated Show prior to the schedule being agreed.
9. The society hopes that by working closely with the Show Secretary any changes or queries can be resolved in an amicable and prompt manner
