Once again here is a lot of information within this bulletin with information received from many counties.

## What's New?

Dear Reader

The below was circulated from South Yorkshire Police last week

"I thought I should make you aware that there have been three sightings in the Hope Valley of two suspicious men with Eastern European accents photographing lots of local horses. This could be a steal to order gang operating locally and we have advised our Hope Valley Riding Club members to be extra vigilant.

1) The men were seen actually in a horse owner's field near Bradwell taking lots of photographs of the three horses. The car was a pinky red but the member did not get the registration number.

2) At our open show on Sunday two men with Eastern European accents were seen photographing lots of horses at the event. This time they were in a white van registration no N253 XAJ

3) The two men were seen again today photographing horses in the valley, this time in a red Landcruiser B16 RBB - see Email below.

We have recommended that any HVRC members seeing any further suspicious incidents report them to the police (contact details in the Email below). Also perhaps you could Email me also so that I can circulate details to our members.

What has become evident that this information has been widely circulated and networked nationally.

Hampshire Horsewatch and Hampshire Constabulary have in the last 24 hours been inundated with information, circulated e mails, texts regarding these vehicles and the men. Some of the messages have been given different slant depending on the senders possible interpretation which may alarm individuals as the information is location specific. There is no indication that many of the reported sightings in Hampshire are correct. What I can say is that as a result of information circulated a positive sighting of the white van reg number N253 XAJ was seen in Chilworth, Southampton today Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2008 close to a livery yard. Two men of East European appearance were seen with the same vehicle on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2008 in the same area.

To members on the Isle of Wight there is no indication that this white van has been on the Island

This proves the point that people who are seen in suspicious circumstances do travel.....distances given that the original information came from Derbyshire area

It also demonstrates that Horsewatch networking is powerful....a bit erratic maybe.....!

However money being tight my son said he'd save his money and buy the poles, which he did!*

*He bought them and he used them for the first time last weekend, the pony was a star! I am so careful and chained the wings to a fence post with a padlock, I made my usual daily visit to the field on Tuesday to find the 4 jump poles stolen!*

*I know this is a trivial crime but it raises all sorts of worries, that someone had climbed over my padlocked gate and had got so close to my beloved animals, not to mention stolen the property of my 11 year old son.*

*I will now be joining Horsecatch, but I am unsure if this is a crime for equestrian items or just for wood as other equestrian items along with additional wood like a plank had been left, bizarre and very frustrating.*

First newsletter for a few weeks as I have been rather tucked up with some issues on-going in Bletchingley. I hope I find you all well and lapping up the warm and pleasant weather.

Whilst on my daily travels from Sussex to Surrey I have noticed over the last few days various caravans appearing in lay-by's around Sussex all seem to be facing in our direction .. Its that time of year again with the Epsom Derby on 6/7th June .. So I would ask landowner and farmers to do the now routine checks of field security.

It seems to have been a success over the last year or two with very few incursions on our area.I will keep you up to date with any information of approaching problems ! Likewise please keep me informed and other farmers/landowners.

The theft of drain covers and drain gutters have been on the increase around the roads of Surrey over the last month or two .. Obviously this a very dangerous situation for motorcyclists etc .. Please bear in mind and keep em peeled ... Please ring in as soon as possible to report any missing drains or gutters.

Did YOU See Incident on M1?

BEDFORDSHIRE Police are appealing for witnesses to an incident that happened on the hard shoulder of the M1 in the early hours of yesterday morning (Thursday, May 22).

It happened at around 7.36am on the northbound carriage, near junction 11, where it appears there was an exchange between the driver of a blue VW Polo and a blue Peugeot.

One of the drivers, a man in his 20s, sustained head injuries and was taken to the Luton & Dunstable Hospital and later transferred to the Royal Free in London where he is in a serious condition.

DI Gary White, of the Beds and Herts Major Crime Unit, wants to establish how the victim sustained his injuries and why.

He is keen to speak to anyone who was on the motorway around that time and saw either vehicle travelling along the motorway or stationary on the hard shoulder.
