Editor's Comment

A member of Horsewatch has reported finding her horse's mane being plaited. These reports are made throughout the course of the year and should be reported to the local police as an unusual or unexplained occurrence. The fact that somebody has taken the trouble to do this indicates that somebody is taking an interest in the horses, and because it is unexplained the incident should be considered suspicious.

Horse owners are encouraged to pay closer attention to their horse's surrounding. If possible neighbours and other users of fields, paddocks and yards in the area concerned should be informed and asked to keep a watchful eye on the horses and property. If anybody is spotted then it is recommended that the police are informed so the incident can be recorded and where appropriate investigated. It would be very useful if horse owners on finding a plait in a horse's mane or tail could photograph it and share it with the police.

Bedfordshire are suffering a spate of tack thefts and are encouraging all owners to postcode their tack and rugs.

Good news for this week is that a missing on loan mare in Gwent has been recovered safely. Sadly two miniature foals have been stolen in Sussex.

Plaited Horse

We have received a report of a plait being found in the mane of a dun Lusitania gelding. The plait was made in such a way that it wouldn't come under. The owner checked their perimeter fence and a tyre triangle was located at an exit point of the field that backs onto a track giving access to the field and route back to a road. The police have given security advice to the owner.

Paint Thrown Over Horse

Between 22:00hrs on 27th June and 11:39hrs on 28th June 2009 in Fareham area a piebald traditional cob tethered in a field had paint put onto its coat by person(s) unknown. The horse was set loose from its tether but located nearby and has subsequently received veterinary attention. This is possibly an isolated incident. However, horse owners are reminded that their animals should be regularly visited and keep a neighbourly eye on other local horses for signs of interference.

Dead Foal Found

The body of a dead foal was found in Vicarage Lane, Curridge on 30TH June 2009. The foal was very young. It was skewbald in colour. The suspicion is that the foal was dumped by a local person. Who knows of a mare in the area that recently gave birth but no longer have their foal with them especially in a, lets say, 10 mile radius of Curridge?

- Lock up cars and don't leave windows open in this warm weather.
- Keep your personal belongings out of site.
- Fly rugs do you have them marked up with postcodes and freezemark numbers? I have had reports of these being stolen off horses in fields.
- Think now about the winter rugs when cleaned use the opportunity to mark them with postcodes and freezemark numbers in HUGE writing so it stands out. We had a few owners' horses get left in fields unruddged because these were stolen off their backs. Simple white gloss paint works. I appreciate it seems all boring, till it happens to you...
